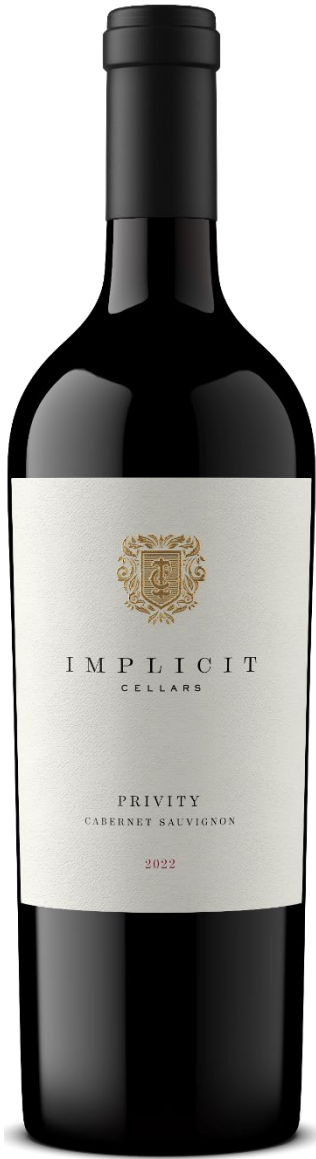

Our mountain vineyard, situated at 1,631 feet in the Atlas Peak AVA of Napa Valley, thrives on rugged, volcanic terrain. Its steep slopes, composed of red and yellow clay loams and fractured rock, promote excellent drainage and contribute to the wines' unique character. With a microclimate offering minimal marine influence and protection from valley winds, the vineyard experiences early warmth and consistent heat, perfect for growing flavorful wines. The site produces wines with intense color, depth, and minerality. Our flagship 2023 PRIVITY features Clone 337 Cabernet Sauvignon from our prized block.

The 2023 grape harvest in the Atlas Peak AVA of Napa Valley was defined by a long, even growing season shaped by a cool, wet start followed by steady, moderate summer conditions. Elevated mountain sites experienced slower ripening, allowing Cabernet Sauvignon and other Bordeaux varieties to develop deep color, firm structure, and refined tannin integration. The extended hang time preserved natural acidity while building layered fruit concentration. Harvest unfolded later than average, but conditions remained stable, producing fruit with excellent balance, purity, and the hallmark intensity associated with Atlas Peak's high-elevation volcanic soils and rugged vineyard terrain.

Winemaker Notes: "The 2023 Privity Cabernet Sauvignon emerges from an outstanding vintage, crafted in extremely limited production of just five barrels. Sourced primarily from the rocky volcanic slopes of Atlas Peak, with a finishing touch of valley floor fruit, it captures both power and refinement from two iconic Napa Valley sites.

Deep garnet in color, it opens with layered aromas of blackberry, cassis, black cherry, graphite, cocoa, cedar, and warm baking spice. The palate is rich and full-bodied, revealing dark fruit, bittersweet chocolate, espresso, and subtle mineral tones. Atlas Peak fruit lends structure and intensity, while valley floor components contribute polished texture and classic elegance.

Aged in 80% new French oak, the oak is seamlessly integrated. The finish is long, polished, and persistent, promising graceful evolution over 15+ years with additional cellaring." ~Kirk Venge
